AM School Access

The front and back doors on the EAST end of the school will be open each morning at 8:00 a.m. Students are welcome to choose to stay inside or go outside once they arrive at school each morning. If students choose to remain inside, they need to stay in the east hall by the lunchroom where supervision can be provided. We should not have students in any of the other halls. To facilitate student dropoff, the front doors on the west side of the school by the kindergarten rooms will be opened at 8:45 a.m. Students are welcome in classrooms after 8:45 a.m. We will continue to have our PM Kindergarten students come to the front door. This will help us keep students safe and our school secure.

As the weather begins to cool, the expectation is for students to go outside on appropriate days. Students need to come dressed for outside play. As the inevitable 'inside day' is needed, we are grateful to our wonderful specialists who will supervise students in the school's vestibules, providing appropriate inside activities.

"Bucket Filling" at Spanish Oaks

This year at Spanish Oaks we are focusing on being "Bucket Fillers"! Each of us has an invisible bucket. It is constantly emptied or filled, depending on what others say or do to us. When our bucket is full, we feel great. When it's empty, we feel awful ... At Spanish Oaks, we fill buckets!

At our Back to School Night we introduced our "bucket filling" focus to parents. During the first week of school Mrs. Brown joined each of the classes and shared *Have You Filled a Bucket Today?* We introduced our buckets, "drops", thank you rewards, weekly winners, posters, etc. The students learned how EVERY faculty and staff member at our school will have "drops" and be giving them out all year long to students they see filling other's buckets, i.e., Mr. Billie might give one to a student for cleaning up in the lunchroom after themselves; Mrs. Downey might give one to a student who walks quietly through the library when asked; Mrs. Johnson might give one to a student who remembered to be on time for school all week long, etc. These "drops" are then returned to the classroom teacher, where teacher keeps track of ALL the drops for the whole month!

Every week teachers will send the name of someone in their class who has been a "Bucket Filler" that week. We will announce their name(s) on Friday morning and invite them to come to the office for a special "thank you" for being awesome bucket fillers! Each weekly recipient will then get to write their name on our gigantic BUCKET poster we have hanging outside the main office!!

In each classroom the teachers will keep track using our "drops" of all the times their students fill someone's bucket ... At the end of the month they will turn in these totals and the bucket-filling winning class will earn a 'thank you' reward activity, i.e., root beer floats, creamies, pizza celebration, popcorn and story, etc., with Mrs. Brown! At the end of the year we will have a whole-school bucket-filling celebration!!
