Spanish Oaks Elementary's School Community Council (SCC) serves as an advisory council to the school administration. State law establishes the following guidelines:

- The SCC will consist of parents, employees, and the principal.
- The SCC will be elected by vote. Parents will elect parents and staff members will elect staff members.
- The SCC will meet monthly. The council meets for one hour each month, usually after school.
- The SCC will address issues that may include, but are not limited to, Trust Lands Planning, Building Needs Assessments, TSSA Plans, Character Education Plans, and Staff Development Plans.
- The SCC will compile an annual performance report of the school to be sent to the Nebo School Board.

If you are interested in running in the election for School Community Council, please fill out the form at the bottom of this sheet and turn it in at the main office by September 1, 2021. A ballot will be sent home for you to cast your vote. The election will run September 8th - 9th.
